AFRICA

NEW LIFE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY

TUITION

Located in a rural village in Swaziland, the New Life Christian Academy is a Christian school that provides quality education, as well as hope for a brighter future for poor and orphaned children. The school is seeking sponsorships to cover the cost of tuition for students who would otherwise not be able to attend school.

Cost: \$35/share for student tuition



SCIENCE LAB

The New Life School is constructing a science laboratory to train its current and future students. Roofing and other building materials are needed to complete the construction which is critical to the operations of the school. Your gift will allow the school to complete the construction of the science laboratory and provide a quality learning facility for underprivileged students.

Cost: \$35/share for science lab



SCHOOL REPAIRS

The New Life School suffered damage to buildings and destruction of property as a result of the recent political unrest in the country. SCHOOL FEES, UNIFORMS, BOOKS & SUPPLIES

The 5Cs Orphanage in Johannesburg, South Africa provides housing, education, and counseling for children who have lost their parents or whose parents cannot provide for them. All school-aged children are provided with uniforms, books, supplies, and tutoring needed to be successful in school. Your gift will provide fees, uniforms, books, and supplies for the kids for the 2022 school year which starts in January. *There are many things in life that can wait, but the needs of a child cannot!*

Cost: \$35/share for school fees, uniforms, books, and supplies



STAFF AND CAREGIVER SUPPORT

Hillbrow is an inner-city section of Johannesburg where there are many homeless children, struggling to cope and survive in an environment that seems hopeless. The 5Cs Orphanage serves the needs of the homeless, hurting, and hungry children. As a result of the COVID-19 crisis, the 5Cs Orphanage is struggling with a budget deficit making it difficult to continue to pay its staff and provide life-saving care for the children. Your donation will provide critical funds that go directly to the care of these vulnerable children in need. *IF NOT US, then who will help? IF NOT NOW, then when?*

FEEDING PROGRAM

The UBCD community center team in Natal prepares meals daily for children and others who live in impoverished conditions. The meals are also delivered to homebound individuals suffering from a chronic or terminal illness. For many of the children, it may be the only meal they have for the day.

Cost: \$30 for 40 meals



TUITION AND BOOKS

The volunteers and staff of UBCD are key to the success and quality of care provided to the vulnerable youth in this impoverished community. The center strives to ensure that all leaders have excellent training and education. Your gift will provide college tuition and books for the community center volunteers and staff.

Cost: \$30/share for tuition and books



MEDICAL COSTS

Themba & Buhle Bhembe are the founders and Directors of the UBCD community center in Natal. They don't have health insurance and their personal income from the center is not sufficient to cover their ongoing medical costs. Your gift will provide them with the critical medical care they need to remain healthy as they tirelessly serve this rural impoverished community.



Literacy courses are holistic in nature and provide an uplift in the areas of education, economic empowerment, family relations, community, environment, sanitation, nutrition, and spirituality. CBS teaches children morals, ethics, songs, and verses.

CARING FOR CHINA

CHICKENS

Caring For China supports Living Stone Ministry, an indigenous nonprofit, which provides vocational training to teenage boys with disabilities. They live and work on a farm in the south of Xi'an, where they grow vegetables and raise chickens to market their eggs. In the New Year's season, they sell the chickens and then start over with baby chicks in the Spring. They have room for several thousand chickens. Free Range eggs are very much in demand and they have no problem selling all they can produce. There are very few places in all of China where boys with disabilities can live in a sheltered environment and learn skills that can help them become self-supporting. Your purchase of one chick can potentially produce hundreds of eggs.



Cost: \$5 per chick

VIKRAM HOUSE (LITTLE DROPS - INDIA)

CARE FOR ELDERLY

Vikram House is located in Chennai, India, and built-in memory of and dedicated to Vikram George Subramanyam (9/4/91 - 2/22/98), who even in his young years, longed for all people to have a roof over their heads and a home to live in. Although Vikram battled Spinal Muscular Atrophy, a debilitating condition that only gave him a few short years to live, he cared about the homeless and underprivileged. This little child's vision is Vikram House- a home that provides care to nearly 400 elderly, destitute and homeless men and women.

Cost: \$63 pays for healthcare for an elderly person for one month.



VIKRAM HOUSE (Little Drops - INDIA) (CONT.)

SCHOOL FOR DISADVANTAGED CHILDREN

Vikram House is part of the Little Drops ministry which also provides quality education from Pre-K through 5th grade at the Little Angels School, for 394 disadvantaged children who otherwise would not be able to attend school. As Mr. Edgar Paul-Founder Director of Little Drops notes: "We firmly believe that we have Vikram, guiding us in our journey to fulfill his wish and vision to help the needy."

Cost: \$38 pays the fees, which includes the uniform, shoes, books and transport for a child for one month.



EUSEY FAMILY - MISSION IN JAPAN

Telling the Gospel Story Amongst the Japanese

After a 6-month Home Assignment in the US, we are excited to return to leading a church plant in snowy northern Japan in Dec 2021/Jan 2022. God is moving in our community in Sapporo, and we have seen people's hearts opening to the light of Christ. Japan is a modern and prosperous nation with a dynamic culture, making it a crucial mission field for the coming century. Although less than 1% of Japanese call themselves Christian, disillusionment with traditional religion, family breakdown, and loneliness have left many longing for the hope of the good news. We have served in Japan since 2011, focusing on Bible storytelling and meaningful community involvement.



Cost: \$10/share (to cover living expenses)

PRAVAHAM SOUTH INDIA

NURSING EDUCATION

Invest in the kingdom by sponsoring a young girl's vocational education at Pravaham, South India. The 1-year certificated, residential, Nursing Aide program trains poverty-stricken, marginalized, and oppressed girls who could not finish high school. At the end of the year, the students have attained an important skill, have learned about Jesus' love, and have full-time jobs at a local hospital or caring for the elderly. You can contribute to dormitory expansion or a full scholarship. Your contributions help pay for room, board, uniforms, and teachers' salaries.



Cost: \$25/share or \$550/Full Sponsorship

EL NIÑO

'DO FOR ONE' SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

You can change the life of a student and the El Niño community through the gift of education! Sponsors receive a photo and info sheet about their sponsored student so that they can pray for him/her throughout the year. Additionally, we encourage scholarship sponsors to correspond with their children and develop lasting relationships. We have students now graduating from university whose parents didn't have the opportunity for school beyond 4th elementary school.

Pastors at Ministerios Transformación churches in and around El Niño, Mexico (near Tijuana) are distributing food packages to families who are suffering due to COVID-19 employment and health difficulties. A contribution of \$20 will buy groceries to help feed a family for one week.



Cost: \$20 provides groceries for a family for a week

TIJUANA CHRISTIAN MISSION (TCM)

TCM provides a loving family environment for children who have experienced abuse, neglect, and extreme poverty. With your support, they clothe, house, feed, and educate over 100 orphan children at two locations.

Cost: \$25/share for school tuition and uniforms

ROYAL FAMILY KIDS

SUMMER CAMP & MENTORING PROGRAM FOR FOSTER CHILDREN

Without intervention, abused and neglected children whose lives have been impacted by being in the foster care system face a very uncertain future. Through our summer camp and year-round mentoring program, our mission at Royal Family Kids is to make a difference in the lives of Orange County foster care children by providing them with positive memories and loving adult Christian role models. In many fun ways, RFK helps to build their self-esteem, plant seeds of hope for the future, and challenge their assumptions that adults are bad and that God has forgotten about them. Above all, they learn that they have a Father in heaven who loves them and who has a positive plan for their future.

You can help send 75-80 children from the Orange County Foster care system to camp this summer.

Cost:

\$500 - Full Camp/Mentoring Scholarship for 1 Child

\$250 - Half Camp/Mentoring Scholarship for 1 Child

KIDWORKS, SANTA ANA

RESTORING AT-RISK NEIGHBORHOODS, ONE LIFE AT A TIME

KidWorks serves more than 700 children and their families in Santa Ana. Daily kindergarten and after-school education programs offered at three neighborhood centers impact more than 3000 community members annually. In addition, KidWorks provides college planning and success mentoring for the students who have attended its after-school education programs. You can help KidWorks continue these services by giving to support various programs.



Cost:

\$25 provides a care package for a KidWorks college student

\$50 provides one hour of tutoring for a student

\$100 provides training for a College Success Mentor

\$250 covers college fees for a student,

\$333 provides Campus Crash for one KidWorks student

SOUTHWEST CENTER

HELP LOCAL PEOPLE IN NEED

For over 30 years volunteers from *Shepherd's Grove/Irvine Presbyterian Church* have prepared a monthly meal for those in need at the Southwest Community Center. Before Covid-19, the Southwest Center served over 10,000 meals a month. The meal service was reduced during the height of Covid. However, now that vaccinations are beginning to be more prevalent, the meal service and other Center services are getting back to normal. The meal service includes 2 meals a day, every day of the week. Other services include providing twice-weekly clothing and food bags to those in need, rental assistance of \$1,500 per month to about 100 families, vaccination clinics, drive-thru tax preparation services, financial assistance to families in partnership with the United Way and Wells Fargo, and Financial Literacy Workshops.

Cost: \$3.00 per meal or a donation of any size to help with the other services that the Center provides.

MINISTRY TO MUSLIMS - HELP AN AFGHANI REFUGEE FAMILY

Over 500,000 Muslims live in Southern California, of which over 120,000 reside in Orange County, making this the second-largest concentration of Muslim people in the USA. They do not know Jesus as Savior and Lord. Jesus loves Muslims! He wants to work through His children to connect Muslims to Him, so they will be with Him in heaven forever. These new Believers will then have the unique opportunity to connect Muslims worldwide to the grace of God through Jesus. Led by the Holy Spirit working through Pastor Nader Hanna, Salam (Peace) Ministries has directly served 15 Muslim families over the past two years and trained over 600 Jesus Followers to disciple Muslims and others in their neighborhoods and life contexts.

Our current need is to welcome and support newly arrived Afghan refugees to our community. They come with nothing, but we can show them the love of Jesus through your generosity and the relationships the Spirit develops with them and our missionaries. Will you help?
